Each year, Corporate Pro Bono (CPBO) presents the CPBO Pro Bono Partner Awards in honor of innovative collaborative approaches to pro bono work involving in-house legal departments. The awards will be presented on Monday, October 27, 2025, at the Pro Bono Institute (PBI) Annual Dinner in New York City and may be presented to any partnership that includes at least one legal department and one or more law firms and/or public interest organization partners. Award winners will be expected to attend the Dinner to accept the Award, and to prepare a video about their partnership.

Award winners are selected based on the following criteria:

- 1) demonstrated impact of the partnership project on its community or target group;
- 2) substantial involvement by in-house lawyers;
- 3) tangible steps toward sustaining the partnership;
- 4) innovative substantive and/or structural (e.g., delivery model) approaches to the effort; and
- 5) addresses a critical legal need and/or particularly vulnerable community/target group.
